Medium-bodied, elegant, and weightless, with fine tannins and even acidity, it's approachable and open now and is going to show its best over the next 5-6 years. It's a very pretty and charming wine with good value.

Bordini**

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The 2021 Barbaresco Bordini displays a medium ruby color with a touch more pigment and is spiced with aromas of red cherries, a delicate touch of licorice, roses, and crushed stones. It takes on a nice amount of tension on the palate, with medium body, ripe tannins, and balanced acidity. While it's going to benefit from year or two in bottle, it's appealing now and is going to drink at its best over the next 10-12 years.

**2021 Fontanabianca Barbaresco  
Serraboella**

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Exhibiting a darker ruby/magenta color although it remains transparent, the 2021 Barbaresco Serraboella shows off a sunnier side of the vintage, with black raspberries, wet stone, violets, and sweet herbs. Medium-bodied, it fills the palate with ripe tannins, ripe, rounded, forward fruit, a heartier texture on the finish, and savory notes of tea leaf that linger on the palate. It's ripe but light on its feet and does a good job of retaining freshness, as do all these wines from Fontanabianca. Drink 2025-2037.
